

The Madison Community House Preschool

The Madison Community House Preschool is a state-licensed, non-profit preschool established in 1960. It is sponsored by the Madison Community House, which is owned and operated by the Thursday Morning Club. The fees are moderate and include supplies.

The goal of the Madison Community House Preschool is to provide an intermediate experience between home and school in a warm nurturing atmosphere where children are comfortable with themselves and their peers. We strive to prepare children to enter school with feelings of confidence and enthusiasm. Our experienced staff is devoted to the social, emotional, intellectual and physical development of each child.

Our renovated facility was completed in January 2009. New construction unveiled two bright new classrooms, two new bathrooms, a central supply room and new gymnasium. Our school provides excellent kitchen facilities for cooking activities and a well-equipped indoor gymnasium. Our fenced-in outdoor playground includes a play scape, play houses, sand box, bike path with tricycles and picnic tables for outdoor activities. Educational and enjoyable field trips are taken to the Fire House, Pet Store, Library, Dentist, Dodge Field, Turtleback Zoo and Pumpkin Farm. We encourage parents to participate in our program. Opportunities for parents to volunteer in special programs are offered throughout the year.
